ANNOUNCING THE 1st ROBINSON GREEN AWARD CONTEST!

Calling all eco-leaders, let's see your creative genius at work! Please submit your GREEN PROJECT idea on the attached page and turn it into the office by **Wednesday, June 7, 2017. Eligible grades 1st-5th.**

Here are the guidelines:

1. Please do not sign your name on your submission as they will be judged anonymously. One submission per student. Make sure your project idea is **attached to THIS COVER SHEET** bearing your name, grade and teacher's name and turn it into the office by June 7, 2017.
2. Your project idea needs to be **GREEN** and it should show how it can **IMPROVE** our school or community. **GREEN** means it is environmentally friendly (zero waste producing, non-toxic, does not use water, does not use electricity, saves electricity/water, etc.) **IMPROVE** means that it helps make our environment better than it is, achieves something greater, and upgrades our school environment. The idea must provide its own budget through external sources, i.e. it cannot cost Robinson.
3. Your **Green Project** idea should be new to Robinson this year. We have already completed green projects including Soles for Souls, plastic water bottle collection, Dimes for Deforestation and book drives. Take your time to think and research an idea that will make a difference at Robinson – make the air cleaner, reduce trash, teach “green” habits, etc.
4. If an individual wins he/she will win an iPad. You can also participate as a small group of up to 10 students across grades. If a group wins, each member will win a reusable S'well bottle.
5. Keep in mind that the project needs to be doable by children.
6. Teacher sponsors are encouraged.
